What is gentleness: A fruit grown in us by the Holy Spirit Galatians 5:22-23

Jesus is gentle as a Shepherd

1 Timothy 3:3

The natural or first response to a stressful situation:

- 1) Protection of rights, territory, desire
- 2) Anger
- 3) Impatience

How to be gentle:

- 1) Develop gentleness as one of your character traits. Colossians 3:12
- 2) Pause before responding. 2 Corinthians 10:1
- 3) Consider the needs of the other person. Ephesians 4:2

Why be gentle:

- 1) It is a powerful witness. Philippians 4:5; 1 Peter 3:15
- 2) We will have less stress. Matthew 11:29
- 3) It brings peace to a tense situation. Titus 3:2; Proverbs 15:1; 16:24
- 4) It is what God expects of us. 1 Timothy 6:11; 1 Peter 3:4
